

Bengalla Mine Incident Register 2021



In accordance with Environmental Protection Licence (EPL) 6538 and State Significant Development (SSD) 5170 (modification 4), Mining Leases and Water Licences Bengalla Mining Company Pty Limited (BMC) is required to notify all relevant authorities of incidents causing or threatening material harm to the environment.

This incident register is provided in accordance with the Web-based Reporting Guideline (Department of Planning and Environment, 2015).

SSD-5170 (modification 4) Definitions:

Incident:

An occurrence or set of circumstances that causes or threatens to cause material harm and which may or may not be or cause a non-compliance.

Material harm:

Is harm that involves actual or potential harm to the health or safety of human beings or to the environment that is not trivial, or results in actual or potential loss or property damage of an amount, or amounts in aggregate, exceeding \$10,000, (such loss includes the reasonable costs and expenses that would be incurred in taking all reasonable and practicable measures to prevent, mitigate or make good harm to the environment). This definition excludes "harm" that is authorised under either SSD-5170 or any other statutory approval.
